and faithfulness.* – Psalm 57 : 1–3

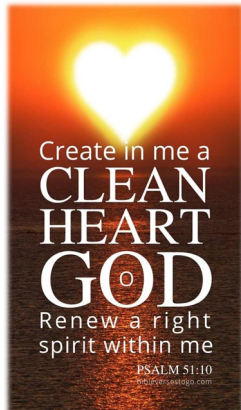
*Let my cry for help reach you,

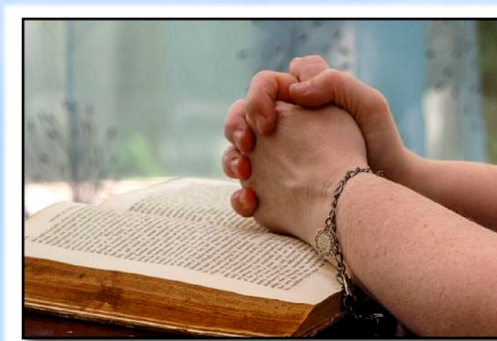
